Many of you will have read the information about the mountain's water problems in the current issue of the T.M. News. Some will have already sent in or delivered the pro forma attached.

Due to an error in the signage displayed by Gillion Pty. Ltd. at their site on Power Parade, the submission period was extended to close on 27th March.

In order to alert as many residents as possible and with limited access to the media, the pro forma with an information insert is being letter box dropped across the whole mountain.

The pro forma is attached to this email for your convenience, together with an information sheet regarding the background to all the water going off the mountain and a brief overview of the Gillion case.

The original long winded Gillion (Power Pde) saga finished with the refusal of Gillion's appeal in the Supreme Court. Legally, Mrs. Gill was able to submit virtually the same Development Application to Council for the whole process to start all over again. There was a time limit for this. Mrs. Gill apparently was prepared for the Court's ultimate refusal, as she was up and running with the re-launch of the Development Application within weeks of the closure at Court.

In case anyone is interested, a letter to the new Minister for Natural Resources is also attached. This is an introduction to our water woes and with luck (& a follow up) bells should start ringing that the State is facing a big expensive problem. Date unknown, but at this rate, this shouldn't be long.

If you feel inclined, please bring the pro forma to the attention of your friends. Today, we have a big hint that Council would like to see a large number of submitters from Tamborine Mountain.
